#### WASTE DISPOSAL OPTIONS FOR RESIDENTS

- ► Flower Mound residents have multiple waste removal options, viewable at <a href="https://www.flower-mound.com/259/Trash-Recycling">https://www.flower-mound.com/259/Trash-Recycling</a>. In addition to weekly trash and recycling collection, residents can:
  - ▶ Dispose of up to 10 cubic yards for free at the Camelot Landfill once per month with proof of residency. Avoid additional fees by covering your load with a tarp! Charges may apply to non-compactible items.
  - ► Schedule a Household Hazardous Waste or E-Waste Collection. Example items include paint, light bulbs, batteries, and televisions etc. Call Republic Services at 469.451.3713.
  - ▶ Schedule a special pick up for a large amount of debris or bulk items that are too large for bulk collection. There is an additional fee of \$45 per hour with a one-hour minimum. Call Republic Services at 469.451.3713.

#### TRASH AND RECYCLING PICKUP

- ► Have trash and recycling carts curbside by 7:00 a.m. on your collection day (no earlier than 8:00 a.m. the day before pickup or later than 8:00 a.m. the day after pickup)
- ▶ Place cart within two feet of the edge of the street with handles facing your house and lid opening facing the street
- ► All items must be inside the cart and the cart may weigh no more than 175 lbs.

#### **BULK WASTE**

- Residents may dispose of up to 4 cubic yards of bulk trash or brush on standard collection days
- ▶ Bulk items must be no larger than 3' x 3' x 12' (yard waste, furniture, household items)
- ▶ Brush must be cut in lengths not to exceed 4 feet and tied into 50 lb. bundles
- ▶ Make sure that no individual branches have a diameter greater than 8 inches
- ▶ Bulk waste may be at the pickup location no earlier than 8:00 a.m. the day before pickup or later than 8:00 a.m. the day after pickup



## **BULK WASTE MISTAKES**

Appliances with Liquid or Gaseous Compounds



▶ Appliances such as refrigerators, freezers, and air conditions that contain Freon, PCB or other liquid or gaseous compounds must have that product removed by a certified technician who places a special tag on the item prior to collection.

#### HOUSEHOLD HAZARDOUS WASTE

- Schedule a Household Hazardous Waste or E-Waste Collection, at your door

#### **Acceptable E-Waste**

- Televisions, Monitors, VCRs
- Computers, Laptops, Handheld
- Keyboards & Mice
- Scanners/Printers/Copiers
- Telephones, Fax Machines
- · Microwave Ovens
- CD Players, Stereo
- Related Cables

#### **Acceptable Household Hazardous Waste**

- ✓ Paint: latex & oil based
- ✓ Paint thinners, gasoline, solvents
- ✓ Oil, petroleum-based lubricants
- ✓ Ethylene glycol, antifreeze
- ✓ Pesticides, herbicides
- ✓ Aerosols
- ✓ Mercury, mercury and debris
- ✓ Batteries: lead acid, alkaline, NiCad
- ✓ Light bulbs: fluorescents, compact fluorescents (CFL), high-intensity
- ✓ HID lamps
- ✓ Pool Chemicals
- ✓ Cleaners: acidic & basic
- √ Resins & epoxy
- ✓ Medical Sharps
- ✓ Empty Propane Tanks

#### HOUSEHOLD HAZARDOUS WASTE

#### **Unacceptable Household Hazardous Waste**

- Commercially generated HHW or e-Waste
- Radioactive compounds
- Smoke Detectors
- Ammunition
- Explosives
- ▼ Tires
- Asbestos
- PCBs (polychlorinated biphenyls)
- Pharmaceuticals or controlled substances
- ☑ Biological or infectious wastes
- Fire Extinguishers

TIP 1: Smoke detector manufacturers/distributors will often take back their products for proper disposal. Contact your manufacturer for more information.

TIP 2: You can dispose of certain unwanted, expired, or unused medications at the Medication Drop Box at the Flower Mound Police Department. Learn more at https://www.flower-mound.com/1247/Medication-Disposal

## SPECIAL PICKUPS AND DUMPSTER RENTALS

- ► Schedule a special pick up for a large amount of debris or bulk items that are too large for bulk collection.
- ► There is an additional fee of \$45 per hour with a one-hour minimum. Call Republic Services at 469.451.3713.
- Dumpsters of various sizes can be rented from Republic Services for remodeling or other home projects. Call Republic Services at 817.317.2000
  - ▶ Dumpsters may not be placed in the street
  - Dumpsters may not block sidewalks or be placed so that they create a drainage problem for neighbors



## CAMELOT LANDFILL

- Dispose of up to 10 cubic yards for free at the Camelot Landfill once per month with proof of residency
- Avoid additional fees by covering your load with a tarp
- ► Fees apply to non-compactible items
- ▶ Residents may access the landfill Monday through Friday from 7 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. and Saturdays from 7 to 11:30 a.m.
